Dear Mr. Burnette:

Agenda Item No. 51 for the upcoming Clark County Commission meeting concerns a proposed ordinance to amend Title 9 of the Clark County Code. The ordinance proposes to implement a single-stream recycling system for residential consumers preserving the present rates while at the same time eliminating a day of general waste collection each week. The proposed ordinance asserts that "it has been demonstrated that a single stream recycling system results in significant increases in recycling rates."

This correspondence shall serve as a public records request for the following:

- 1. All documents that address, reference or concern the assertion that it has been demonstrated that such a system results in significant increase in recycling rates.
- 2. All documents concerning any analysis, review or consideration of potential cost savings that the franchisee expects to receive as a result of the proposed changes and the basis for concluding that consumers should not receive a corresponding rate decrease to reflect the cost savings that are achieved by eliminating a day of waste retrieval.

As you know under the law, "documents" include not just physical paper, but also information stored or received in an electronic format, which includes emails or other electronic means of information transmittal.

This request covers documents that exist as of the date of this correspondence, as well as those that are subsequently generated or later come in to the County's possession concerning this agenda item. In that regard, as part of the production, I request that any documents that are received or generated after the date of this correspondence be

separately segregated and identified. One purpose of this request is to identify the documentation that the County possessed as of the date of the agenda's preparation and thus considered prior to receiving this request.
