## Win Revenue Summary - April 2013

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of $\$ 854,293,047$ for the month of April 2013. This amounts to a $0.16 \%$ decrease compared to April 2012, when licensees reported a gaming win of $\$ 855,674,603$. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2012 through April 30, 2013), gaming win has increased $\mathbf{2 . 4 4 \%}$.

## Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of May 2013

The State collected $\$ 47,217,357$ in percentage fees during the month of May 2013, based upon the taxable revenues generated in April 2013. This represents a $2.78 \%$ (or $\$ 1,347,967$ ) decrease compared to the prior year's May, when percentage fee collections were $\mathbf{\$ 4 8 , 5 6 5 , 3 2 4}$.
